GCSE Results Day – Thursday 20 August 2020

I am writing to confirm the arrangements for the collection of this summer's GCSE examination results. Due to the current circumstances with Covid-19 we will continue to adhere to the government guidance and social distancing until further notice.

To limit the number of people we have together at any one time, we will only be allowing you on site to collect your results. This means that any family members will not have access the academy. We will also not be allowed family members or peers to gather by the entrance gates.

To collect your results you must arrive between 9am and 1pm. When on site, you will be expected to abide by the social distancing in place and there will be members of the Senior Leadership team present to welcome you and ensure you remember these guidelines. Students will be required to queue outside of the building until invited to collect their results in single file. Therefore, please be mindful of the weather as the good old British summer cannot always be relied upon.

There will be many familiar faces to welcome and support you. However, once your results have been collected, we will continue to keep the time spent on site to a minimum. You will be able to book online appointments for remote conversations with Mr Eley, our Head of Sixth form, and Ian Doherty, our careers advisor. If you achieve the criteria for acceptance into Sixth Form, please complete the online registration form that will be sent to you on the morning of results day to confirm your place at the academy.

The National Careers Service has also set up an exam results helpline during August. Whilst I would advise using our in house advisor, students and their parents can contact the helpline on 0800 100 900. The helpline will be open from 8am to 10pm from Thursday 13th August until Friday 28th August.

As per my previous correspondence, we look forward to seeing you on results day and hope to also see you for our re-arranged prom and celebration evening organised by Mrs Bonner.
