Behaviour protocol (May 2018)

On Call (3 Persistent Disruptive Behaviour [PDB] points)

Students can accumulate 3 behaviour points during the day from staff for disruption of teaching and learning (see steps below).

Students remain in IE until the end of the next break (break, lunch or until 3.40pm).

First Warning

Verbal reminder by the teacher (not recorded on class charts) and discussion with the student and agree target for improvement

PDB 1 – Reflection sheet

Recorded on Class Charts x 1 Behaviour point

This is used for all types of behaviour that disrupts the teaching and learning in the classroom

PDB 2 – Removal from classroom

Recorded on Class Charts x 1 Behaviour point

If refusal to go to another classroom – Emergency On Call (Other)

PDB 3 – Continued disruptive behaviour

If continued poor behaviour following removal – record on Class Charts as “Disruptive behaviour following removal”

EMERGENCY ON CALL (4 Behaviour points)

To be used when teaching and learning cannot continue unless the student is removed e.g. swearing at staff, fighting etc.

Students remains in I.E. until issue is resolved

Class Charts

Behaviour points system

- 1 non-PDB points

(action by class teacher/tutor)

- No equipment
- Inadequate work
- No homework
- Late for school

- 1 PDB points

- Late for lesson
- Disruptive behaviour (Reflection sheet)
- Removal from classroom
- Disruptive behaviour after removal

- 4 points (Emergency on call)

- Assault / Fighting
- Verbal abuse to staff
- Truancy
- Vandalism
- Other significant poor behaviour

Sanctions

- **3+ PDBs in 1 day** = removed to IE & same day detention
- **6+ PDBs accrued in a week or 3+ lates to school in a week** = Friday detention for 1 hour or 1 hour 30
- All of these generate an email and class charts message to parents

Referred to HOY (no immediate removal)

- Mobile phone / Personal technology
- Bullying
- Smoking
- Prejudice incident
- Other significant concern
